These are programs which are run by city recreation departments, county agencies, clubs and organizations, or interested individuals. School programs are not included in the list. Parents should be advised that for some programs, registrations must be submitted a month or so prior to the start of the program. Fees and contact people also vary from year to year. Parents are also urged to check out fitness centers, bowling alleys, local church youth groups, mini golf, dance studios etc.

Algoma



Youth Club- Open for youth from mid-September to early July . Ages: 4th-12th graders on evenings and weekends. (Grades 1 and up welcome on weekend afternoons.) Cost: \$1.00 membership fee each year. Additional fees charged for dances. Contact Terry Qualman at the club (487-5480).

Park and Recreation Activities

- ◆ Summer Rec –Held at the Perry Field Park 9-4 on Mon.-Fridays for 10 weeks in summer. Activities: games, crafts, wading pool and field trips (for additional cost).
- ◆ Art crafts/basketball days on weekends in the winter at the Youth Club for grade school age youth.
